

**Col 2:14** Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

**Rom 6:14** For sin shall not have dominion over you: **for ye are not under the law, but under grace.**

**Eph 2:11** Wherefore remember, that ye *being* in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands; **Eph 2:12** That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

**Act 2:38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and **be baptized** every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ **for the remission of sins**, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

**Luk 22:1** Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, **which is called the Passover.**

**Luk 22:7** Then came the day of **unleavened bread**, when the **passover** must be killed.

**Exo 12:3** Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth *day* of this month they shall take to them every man a **lamb**, according to the house of *their* fathers, a **lamb** for an house:

**Joh 1:29** The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

**1Pe 1:18** Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things...1Pe 1:19 But with the precious blood of Christ, **as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:**

**1Co 5:7** ...For even Christ **our passover** is sacrificed for us:

**Rom 3:23** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

**1Co 12:13** For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

**1Th 5:19** Quench not the Spirit.

**Eph 4:30** And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. **Eph 4:31** Let all **bitterness, and wrath, and anger**, and clamour (*outcry*), and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

**Eph 5:18** And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; **but be filled with the Spirit;** Eph 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

**Col 3:15** And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. **Col 3:16** **Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing** one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. **Col 3:17** And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

**Rom 12:1** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service. **Rom 12:2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**Gal 5:22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, **Gal 5:23** Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. **Gal 5:24** And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. **Gal 5:25** If we **live in** the Spirit, let us also **walk in** the Spirit.

**Joe 2:28** And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* I will **pour out my spirit upon all flesh**; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: **Joe 2:29** And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in **those days** will I pour out my spirit.

**Mat 24:21** For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. **Mat 24:22** And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

**Jer 9:13** And the LORD saith, Because they have forsaken my law which I set before them, and have not obeyed my voice, neither walked therein; **Jer 9:14** But have walked after the imagination of their own heart, and after Baalim, which their fathers taught them: **Jer 9:15** Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will feed them, *even* this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink. **Jer 9:16** I will scatter them also among the heathen...

**Lev 26:33** And I will scatter you among the heathen...

**Deu 28:64** And the LORD shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other gods, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, *even* wood and stone.

**Zec 8:23** Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days *it shall come to pass*, that ten men shall take hold out of **all languages of the nations**, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that **is a Jew**, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard *that* God *is* with you.

**Heb 6:5** ...the powers of the age to come,

**Exo 23:14** Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year. **Exo 23:15** Thou shalt keep the feast of **unleavened bread**...**Exo 23:16** And the feast of harvest (**Pentecost**)... and the feast of ingathering (**Tabernacles**), *which is* in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labours out of the field.**Exo 23:17** Three times in the year all thy males shall appear before the Lord GOD.

**Act 4:13** Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

**Act 17:32** And when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this *matter*. **Act 17:34** Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and believed...

**1Co 4:1** Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God. **1Co 4:2** Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.

**1Co 1:22** For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom:

**Rom 11:11** ...but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.

**1Co 13:8** Charity never faileth: but whether *there be* prophecies, they shall fail; whether *there be* tongues, they shall cease; whether *there be* knowledge, it shall vanish away. **1Co 13:9** For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. **1Co 13:10** But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.

**2Co 12:1** It is not expedient for me doubtless to glory. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord.

**Rom 1:16** For I am not ashamed of the **gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth**; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

**Rom 10:17** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by **the word of God**.
