

Act 2:32 This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. **Act 2:33** Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God...

Joh 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.

Joh 10:30 I and *my* Father are one.

Joh 10:31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Php 2:6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: **Php 2:7** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: **Php 2:8** And being found in fashion as a man, **he humbled himself**, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Php 2:9 Wherefore God also hath **highly exalted him**, and given him a name which is above every name: **Php 2:10** That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; **Php 2:11** And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) **Eph 2:6** And hath **raised us up** together, and **made us sit** together **in heavenly places** in Christ Jesus:

Eph 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:

Act 5:30 The God of our fathers **raised up Jesus**, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

Joh 10:17 Therefore doth my Father love me, **because I lay** down my life, that **I might take it again**. **Joh 10:18** No man taketh it from me, but **I lay it down of myself**. I have power to lay it down, and I have **power to take it again**. This commandment have I received of my Father.

Joh 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

1Ti 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners...

Act 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain:

Mar 15:13 And they cried out again, Crucify him. **Mar 15:14** Then Pilate said unto them,

Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him.

Mat_27:24 When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but *that* rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed *his* hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye *to it*.

Mar 15:15 And so Pilate, **willing to content the people**, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged *him*, to be crucified.

Luk 24:40 ...he shewed them *his* hands and *his* feet.

Luk 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

Act 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be **witnesses** unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Mat 27:25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood *be* on us, and on our children.

Num 15:27 And if any soul sin through ignorance, then he shall bring a she goat of the first year for a sin offering. **Num 15:28** And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him.

Num 15:29 Ye shall have one law for him that sinneth through ignorance, *both for* him that is born among the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them. **Num 15:30** But the soul that doeth *ought* presumptuously, *whether he be* born in the land, or a stranger, the same reproacheth the LORD; and that soul shall be cut off from among his people. **Num 15:31** Because he hath despised the word of the LORD, and hath broken his commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; **his iniquity shall be upon him.**

Luk_23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they **know not** what they do...

Act 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, **lay not this sin to their charge.** And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

Rom 11:11 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.

Col 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Eph 1:13 ...after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

Rom 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

2Co 5:21 For he hath made him **to be sin for us**, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is the gift of God*: **Eph 2:9** Not of works, lest any man should boast.
