

Php 3:5 circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of the Hebrews; concerning the law, a **Pharisee**;

Jer 23:1 Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD.

1Ti 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

Exo 34:30 And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of **his face shone**; and they were afraid to come nigh him.

1Sa 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.

Luk 23:23 And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be crucified. And the voices of them and of the chief priests prevailed.

Col 4:5 Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time. **Col 4:6** Let your speech *be* always with grace, **seasoned with salt**, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.

Gen 12:1 Now the LORD **had** said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a **land** that I will shew thee: **Gen 12:2** And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: **Gen 12:3** And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. **Gen 12:4** So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and **Lot went with him**: and Abram *was* seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

Heb 11:8 By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

Gen 11:31 And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife; and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, to go into the land of Canaan; **and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there.** **Gen 11:32** And the days of Terah were two hundred and five years: and **Terah died in Haran.**

Gen 13:11 Then Lot chose him all the plain of Jordan; and Lot journeyed east: and they separated themselves the one from the other. **Gen 13:12** Abram dwelled in the land of Canaan, and Lot dwelled in the cities of the plain, and pitched *his* tent toward Sodom.

Gen 14:16 And he brought back all the goods, and also brought again his brother Lot, and his goods, and the women also, and the people.

Gen 19:1 And there came two angels to Sodom at even; and **Lot sat in the gate of Sodom...**

2Sa 19:8 Then the king arose, and sat in the gate. And they told unto all the people, saying, Behold, the king doth sit in the gate...

Dan 2:49 Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon: but Daniel sat in the gate of the king.

Gen 19:15 And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city. **Gen 19:16** And while **he lingered**, the men laid hold upon his hand, and upon the hand of his wife, and upon the hand of his two daughters; the LORD being merciful unto him: and they brought him forth, and **set him without the city.**

Gen 19:37 And the firstborn bare a son, and called his name Moab: the same is the father of the Moabites unto this day. **Gen 19:38** And the younger, she also bare a son, and called his name Benammi: the same is the father of the children of Ammon unto this day.

2Pe 2:7 And **delivered just Lot**, vexed (troubled) with the filthy conversation of the wicked:
2Pe 2:8 (For that **righteous man** dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed *his* righteous soul from day to day with *their* unlawful deeds;)

Jos 24:1 And Joshua gathered all the tribes of Israel to Shechem, and called for the elders of Israel, and for their heads, and for their judges, and for their officers; and they presented themselves before God. **Jos 24:2** And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood (River) in old time, *even* Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: **and they served other gods.**

Heb 11:9 By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as *in* a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

Gen 17:14 And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant.

Gen 15:6 And he **believed in the LORD**; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

Rom 4:3 For what saith the scripture? **Abraham believed God**, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

Act 15:39 And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other...

Rom 4:19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: **Rom 4:20** He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; **Rom 4:21** And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. **Rom 4:22** And therefore it was **imputed to him for righteousness.**

Rom 4:23 Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him; **Rom 4:24** **But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;** **Rom 4:25** Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.

Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Gal 3:29 And if ye *be* Christ's, then are ye **Abraham's seed**, and heirs according to the promise.

Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: **Eph 2:9** Not of works, lest any man should boast.

1Ti 1:16 Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.
