

Rom 3:1 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit *is there* of circumcision? **Rom 3:2** Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God.

Luk 2:25 And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name *was* Simeon; and the same man *was* just and devout, waiting for the consolation (comfort) of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. **Luk 2:26** And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Luk 2:29 Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: **Luk 2:30** **For mine eyes have seen thy salvation**, Luk 2:31 Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; **Luk 2:32** **A light to lighten (bring revelation to) the Gentiles**, and the glory of **thy people Israel**.

Luk 2:38 And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that **looked for redemption in Jerusalem**.

Luk 2:32 A light to *bring* revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel."

Joh 1:11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

Joh 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

Deu 7:6 For thou *art* an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that *are* upon the face of the earth.

Deu 14:2 For thou *art* an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that *are* upon the earth.

Eze 16:17 Thou hast also taken thy fair jewels of my gold and of my silver, which I had given thee, and madest to thyself images of men, and didst **commit whoredom** with them, **Eze 16:18** And tookest thy brodered garments, and coveredst them: and thou hast set mine oil and mine incense before them.

2Ki 17:6 In the ninth year of Hoshea the king of Assyria took Samaria, and **carried Israel away into Assyria**, and placed them in Halah and in Habor *by* the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes.

Dan 1:1 In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, **and besieged it**.

Dan 2:13 And the decree went forth that the wise *men* should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain.

Dan 9:2 In the first year of his reign I Daniel **understood by books** the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to **Jeremiah the prophet**, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

Dan 9:25 Know therefore and understand, *that* from the going forth of the commandment to **restore and to build Jerusalem** unto the **Messiah the Prince** *shall be* seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

Neh 2:5 And I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found favour in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it.

Num 24:17 I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a **Star out of Jacob**, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth. **Num 24:18** And **Edom shall be a possession**, Seir also shall be a possession for his enemies; and **Israel shall do valiantly**.

Luk 2:10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

Mic 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, *though* thou be little among the thousands of Judah, *yet* out of thee shall he come forth unto me *that is* to be ruler in Israel...

Mich 5:2b...and his goings forth were from the beginning, even from eternity.

Act 9:7 And the men which journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice, but **seeing no man**.

Luk 2:4 And Joseph also went **up from Galilee**, out of the **city of Nazareth**, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) **Luk 2:5** To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

1Ki 10:1 And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions. **1Ki 10:2** And she came to Jerusalem with a very great train, with camels that bare spices, and very **much gold, and precious stones**: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

Isa 60:9 Surely the isles (distant lands) shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their **silver and their gold** with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he hath glorified thee. **Isa 60:10** And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee. **Isa 60:11** Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that *men* may bring unto thee the **forces (wealth)** of the Gentiles, and *that* their kings *may be* brought. **Isa 60:12** For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, **those nations shall be utterly wasted**.

Exo 30:7 And Aaron shall burn thereon **sweet incense** every morning: when he dresseth the lamps, he shall burn incense upon it. **Exo 30:8** And when Aaron lighteth the lamps at even, he shall burn incense upon it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations.

Exo 30:34 And the LORD said to Moses: "Take sweet spices, stacte and onycha and galbanum, and **pure frankincense** with *these* sweet spices; there shall be equal amounts of each. **Exo 30:35** You shall make of these **an incense**, a compound according to the art of the perfumer, salted, pure, *and* holy. **Exo 30:36** And you shall beat *some* of it very fine, and put some of it before the Testimony in the tabernacle of meeting where I will meet with you. It shall be most holy to you. (NKJV)

Lev 2:1 And when any will offer a meat offering unto the LORD, his offering shall be *of* fine flour; and he shall pour oil upon it, and put frankincense thereon:

Joh 19:39 And there came also Nicodemus, which at the first came to Jesus by night, and brought a **mixture of myrrh and aloes**, about an hundred pound *weight*. **Joh 19:40** Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.

Psa 95:6 O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

Act 16:30 ...**what must I do to be saved?**

Act 16:31 ...Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved...

Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service. **Rom 12:2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

1Th 5:14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all *men*. **1Th 5:15** See that none render evil for evil unto any *man*; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all *men*. **1Th 5:16** Rejoice evermore. **1Th 5:17** Pray without ceasing. **1Th 5:18** In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
