

Act 2:16 But this is that which was spoken **by the prophet Joel**; **Act 2:17** And it shall come to pass in **the last days**, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

Jer 23:5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. **Jer 23:6** In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this *is* his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Act 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Exo 19:6 And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

Act 2:43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

Act 6:8 And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.

Act 5:14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)

Eph 3:9 And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

Act 6:15 And all that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel.

Exo 34:35 And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

Gen 37:3 Now **Israel loved Joseph** more than all his children, because he *was* the son of his old age: and he made him a coat of *many* colours.

Mat 3:17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Gen 37:4 And when his brethren saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him. **Gen 37:5** And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told *it* his brethren: **and they hated him yet the more.**

Luk 19:14 But his citizens **hated him**, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this *man* to reign over us.

Gen 37:9 And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me.

Gen 37:10 ...Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to **bow down ourselves** to thee to the earth? **Gen 37:11** And his brethren **envied him**; but his father observed the saying.

Gen 37:8 And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us?

Luk 19:14 But his citizens hated him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this *man* to reign over us.

Joh 1:11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

Mat 26:65 Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy; what further need have we of witnesses? behold, now ye have heard his blasphemy.

Gen 37:23 ...they stript Joseph out of his coat, *his coat of many colours that was on him*; **Gen 37:24** And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit *was empty, there was no water in it*.

Mat 27:1 When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people **took counsel against Jesus** to put him to death:

Mat 27:28 And they **stripped him**, and put on him a scarlet robe.

Gen 37:28 Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty *pieces* of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

Gen 39:2 And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

Gen 42:8 And Joseph knew his brethren, but they knew not him.

Gen 42:6 And Joseph *was* the governor over the land, *and he it was* that sold to all the people of the land: and Joseph's brethren came, and **bowed down** themselves before him *with* their faces to the earth.

Gen 45:1 Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.

Act 3:17 "Yet now, brethren, I know that you did *it* in ignorance, as *did* also your rulers.

Luk 23:34 ...Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.

Act 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; **Act 3:20** And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: **Act 3:21** Whom the heaven must receive until the times of **restitution of all things**, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

Exo 1:5 And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were **seventy souls**: for Joseph was in Egypt *already*.

Gen 46:26 All the souls that came with Jacob into Egypt, which came out of his loins, besides Jacob's sons' wives, all the souls *were* **threescore and six**;

Php 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: **Php 2:8** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and **became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross**.

Rom 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: **Eph 2:9** Not of works, lest any man should boast.
