

**Act 8:1** Now **Saul** was consenting to his death. At that time a great persecution arose against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.

**Act 6:5** And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip...

**Act 8:12** But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

**Act 8:17** Then laid they *their* hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

**1Co 12:13** For by **one Spirit are we all baptized into one body**, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles...

**Col 2:13** And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having **forgiven you** all trespasses;

**2Co 5:21** For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

**Col 3:3** For ye are dead, and your life is **hid with Christ in God**.

**Col 2:10** And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

**Eph 1:13** In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye **heard the word of truth**, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also **after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise**, **Eph 1:14** Which is the **earnest of our inheritance** until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

**Php 3:20** For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: **Php 3:21** Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body...

**Eph 5:18** And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be **filled with the Spirit**...

**Gal 5:16** *This* I say then, **Walk in the Spirit**...

**Isa 60:3** And the Gentiles shall **come to thy light**, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

**Zec 8:22** Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD. **Zec 8:23** Thus saith the LORD of hosts; In those days *it shall come to pass*, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard *that God is with you*.

**Col 1:25** ...became a minister according to the stewardship from God which was given to me for you, to **fulfill the word of God**, **Col 1:26** the mystery...

**1Co 13:10** But when that which is **perfect is come**, then that which is in part shall be done away.

**Act 13:2** ...**the Holy Ghost said**, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

**Act 28:8** ...to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him.

**2Ti 4:20** ...Trophimus have I left at Miletum sick.

**1Ti 2:4** Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

**Eph 1:16** Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; **Eph 1:17** That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of **wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: Eph 1:18** The eyes of **your understanding** being enlightened; that ye **may know what** is the hope of his calling, and **what** the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, **Eph 1:19** And **what** is the exceeding greatness of **his power to us-ward who believe**, according to the working of his mighty power,

**Eph 3:3** How that by revelation he made known unto me **the mystery**; (as I wrote afore in few words, **Eph 3:4** Whereby, when ye read, **ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ**)

**Rom 1:20** For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; **so that they are without excuse:**

**Isa 53:7** He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a **lamb to the slaughter**, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. **Isa 53:8** He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was **cut off** out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

**Mat 16:16** And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

**Joh 20:31** But these are written, that ye might believe that **Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God**; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

**1Jn 5:1** Whosoever believeth that **Jesus is the Christ** is born of God...
